TOUR PROVISIONS:

Included in all tours are experienced tour guides. Not included in the cost of the tour are travel to/from the tour starting point, motorcycle shipping, repairs, visas and other travel permits, travel insurance, food and beverages, and other incidentals or personal items. Motorcycle rentals are not included unless specifically stated in the individual tour description.

RHMT (Road Horse Motorcycle Tours, LLC) may cancel a tour if an insufficient number of tour participants have booked and fully paid by 10 days prior to scheduled tour start. Should RHMT cancel a tour for any reason, full refunds will be made. All participants are urged to obtain travel/trip insurance should they be unable to attend their scheduled tour.

MOTORCYCLE RENTALS:

We reserve a motorcycle of your choice for you in each tour. It will be in your name and you will be responsible for that motorcycle. The motorcycle vendors will require a credit card for the price of your rental, sales tax, fees, insurance and damage deposit.

Motorcycle rider helmets may cost extra or may be included in the cost of the motorcycle rental.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICY:

Payment in full for each person (rider and passenger, if applicable) is required to secure your reservation.

Full payment by 10 days prior to the date of departure is required for every reservation.

If RHMT receives a notice of cancellation, in writing, at least 11 days prior to the date of departure, all monies submitted will be returned, less a \$35 administrative fee per person per tour.

There is no refund if written cancellation is received within 10 days or less of tour start date.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION:

Tour participants must be 24 years or older and possess a valid motorcycle operators license. All motorcycles must comply with laws regarding safety equipment. RHMT requires our clients to have a minimum of 2 years riding experience and believe it is essential that all riders have sufficient skill and experience to safely handle a variety of weather and road conditions.
